I have published a number of articles for Taylor & Francis journals since 2008, including a book in 2009 with Taylor & Francis's imprint Routledge. I've chosen to publish through Taylor & Francis over the years as it is a large international publisher with global reach, and it also has a reputation for publishing highly regarded research with strong peer review integrity.

I have found the production editors to be very helpful when putting together the PDF proofs, particularly when it comes to issues such as formatting, and on things like references and footnotes, to make sure they are in the right styles for the particular journal or book I am publishing in.

I would advise be persistent and vigilant throughout the entire publication process, from submission through peer review to final acceptance and publication. All I can really finally say is good luck!
