

Registering new animal names in ZooBank

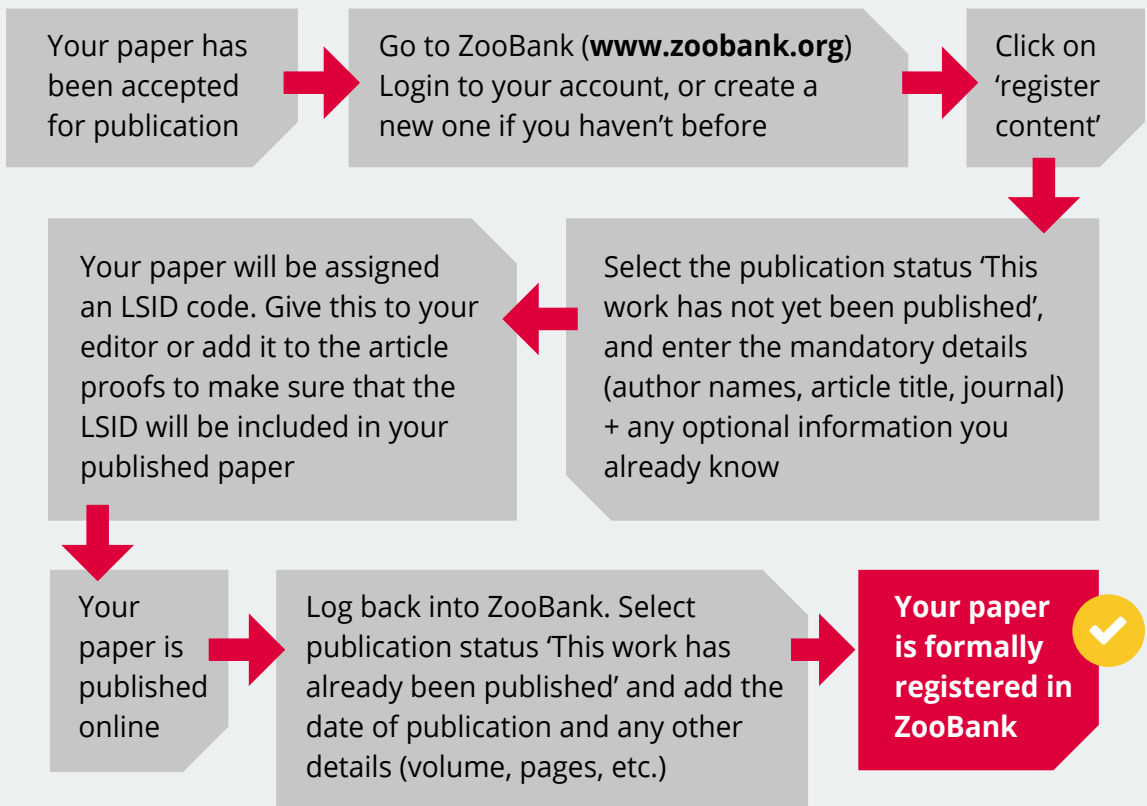
What is ZooBank?

- The official registry of the International Commission on Zoological Nomenclature (ICZN).
- An authoritative resource for scientific names in zoology.
- A register designed to record all published usages of scientific names for animals which represent nomenclatural acts as governed by the *International Code of Zoological Nomenclature*.

My paper describing a new species of animal has been accepted for publication. Why should I register my paper in ZooBank?

- If your article is going to be published online, registration in ZooBank is required by the ICZN Code.
- Registering your paper in ZooBank ensures that it is officially recorded as the first paper to describe this species.
